

REVALUATION UNIT

The Revaluation Unit is built to our own design and specification to provide the perfect solution to secure, accurate and efficient cash collection. They can accept notes and coins in both Sterling and Euros and, like all our system units, are networked for real-time, online transactions, and can be operated using a swipe card, smartcard, PIN number or a fingerprint recognition. Account credits are immediately available for use at POS.

Fixing the Units

We request that the client's electrical contractor fixes and cables the units into position as part of the cabling process. Cabling instructions detailing required height and positioning will be supplied directly to the nominated contractor.

The coin only units weigh 18.5 kg and are 400mm high, 400 mm wide and 210 mm deep. Combined 'note and coin' units are c.150 mm wider and weigh 24 kg.

For a standard unit in a senior school the base of the Revaluation Unit should be 1040mm above the floor, for a Junior School or for disabled access this should be adjusted to 745mm.

Card / Biometric Readers

If card readers are to be used, the units require a single Cat 5e data point and a single 3 AMP non-switched spur. If biometric readers are to be used, each unit requires two data points and two 3 AMP non-switched spurs.

Positioning of Cables

Spurs should be wall-mounted adjacent to the bottom right-hand corner of the unit, with no exposed cabling. Kettle leads, supplied by CRB, should be fed out from inside the unit & wired into the spurs. CAT5e data cables should be fed into the unit, with no exposed cabling, & terminated into data points.

Under special circumstances an aperture can be created in the back of the units to allow cables to enter directly from behind, remaining invisible and inaccessible to users.

Studded Walls

Where the unit is to be sited on a studded wall, metallic A-frame support units can be supplied.
